#### RENOVATION OF THE PANJWANI BLOCK


Dr. Panjwani School Complex for the Blind at Ida Rieu was inaugurated in the year 2000 the President of Pakistan. In the Summer of 2019, this large building complex was total refurbished under the personal supervision and courtesy of Madam Nadira Panjwar Refurbishments included repair and restoration works, provision of new facilities, reconfiguration of many spaces, plantation and landscaping works and aesthetic enrichment of the comple This exercise took six months and has given the building a totally fresh and immaculate loo The lay out, facilities and teaching material in the Montessori section have been enhance in a number of ways presenting a much brighter outlook. The little ones in this section remain engaged in learning and fun activities throughout the day. Principal and her support staff has been stationed in this block to ensure closer supervision of teachers and students in the academic zone of the IRWA campus.

The Low Vision facility has been expanded. Valuable low vision aids and equipments like ima magnifiers, TV screens, spot light lamps, large print books and customized work stations has been provided here for the ready use of low sighted children. Music is a source of great jumple and pleasure for our students and their music room has been refitted with new furnitum music instruments and accompaniments. Attractive collage prints of leading musicians of tworld adorn the walls of the music hall fascinating all visitors who always stop by to appreciate and encourage the musical skills of our students. Two designated classrooms have been the state of t





up for Braille training, housing 24 brand new Braillers. Students have daily practice sessions. A reading room has been set up with a sizeable collection of large print books and Braille books for developing their reading habits. The school Lecture Hall has been air-conditioned and fitted with audio visual equipment including a high resolution projector. This has made the lecture sessions very comfortable for all participants. Soon after the make over of the lecture hall a series of workshops and seminars of international standard were conducted in this large facility. Regular training sessions for faculty members and students are also carried out in this space. The school Gymnasium has been advanced with all the required paraphernalia and various models of exercising machines and treadmills. Students participate in their gym activities enthusiastically and are gradually showing better physical deportment.







There are two large and well equipped Computer labs in the Panjwani Complex. One is for the Blind section and the other for the Deaf section. Both labs have been reset with better furniture and seating arrangements. Special software is used for the computer training of the Blind students. A new science lab has been set up to acquaint students of both sections with principles and concepts of modern science. Models, charts, apparatus, scientific devices, and all relevant material have been provided for science tutorials. A secure examination cell has been set up to ensure safe keeping of Exam related documents and papers. A dedicated clinic has been set up for providing psychological counselling to students, their parents and teachers in total privacy and comfort. Faculty members have been provided with a new rest and relaxation zone on the second floor where they can have a short break, interact and enjoy refreshments. The school kitchen has also been redone and tidied up.

In September 2019 on conclusion of the renovations, a short video was filmed on location and uploaded on the IRWA website for public viewing. Madam Nadira Panjwani personally oversaw the entire ambit of the works carried out thereby ensuring an island of excellence for our visually impaired students in this school complex.








# Training Session on Augmentative and Alternative Communication




#### Performance on Metro TV



IRWA participated and displayed artistic skills like singing and painting at Rangoon-Wala Hall, Karachi.




A Special Cricket Match for the Deaf was organized by the Quaid-e-Azam Rangers School and our students lifted the trophy.
















**Annual Sports Day**


























































# **Health & Fitness**

IRWA is committed to the physical and mental fitness of its students. Every year students undergo an eye and hearing checkup, the results of checkups are shared with the parents and they are facilitated for further assessment.

A well-maintained Clinic with the cooperation of the Inner Wheel is fully functional in the Panjwani Block. A lady doctor is there to provide first aid and Ultrasound services to the students and the teachers. The services of Inner Wheel Clinic are sincerely appreciated. Students presenting any major problem are referred to the Zainab Panjwani Memorial Hospital where totally free of cost treatment is provided to them.








# **Psychological Counseling**

Dr. Madiha Latif, a Senior Psychologist at the Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Dow University of Health Sciences and visiting Psychologist at the Zainab Panjwani Memorial Hospital provides guidance and counselling to the students, their parents and the faculty members regularly on a gratis basis. Her counselling helps significantly in dealing with the emotional and psychological challenges of our special children.

Monthly eye checkups of students of both the Blind and Deaf Sections are carried out by LRBT and Kharun Nisa Hospital. IRWA also collaborates with other institutes and hospitals from time to time to provide eye checkups for our students.


- A workshop on Speech Therapy was conducted by experienced speech therapist and sign language trainer Ms. Saba and Mr. Ageel Ur Rehman.






Shifaat
















#### Our Esteemed Visitors

#### LOUIS BRAILLE




Louis Braille was born in 1809 in France. At the age of three he lost his eyesight due to accidental trauma. When he was 15, he invented a universal system of reading and writing to be used by blinds. He published his first Braille book in 1829.

Braille is read by passing one's fingertips over characters made up of an arrangement of c to six embossed points. The relative positions of these points represent different alphanume characters. Braille can be written with a Braille writer similar to a type writer or by using pointed stylus to punch dots through paper using an instrument called a Braille slate when has rows of small cells in it as a guide.

Braille has been adapted to almost every known language and is an essential tool for t

visually impaired everywhere.
